It typically occurs from July to October, as the animals cross the Mara River, facing obstacles like predators and treacherous currents. 


ITINERARY

DAY 01

Nairobi – Maasai Mara Game Reserve


Meet and greet at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport by "OUR Representatives and have a short introduction and briefing about your safar. After briefing, you will depart to the Mara Reserve, home to the big five and numerous plains game. You will arrive in time for check in and lunch before departing for afternoon game drives. Optional activities include hot air balloon safari, guided nature walks, bush lunch/dinner/breakfast, bird walks, and evening sundowner. All meals and overnight at Jambo Mara Safari Lodge.



DAY 02

Maasai Mara Full-Day Game Drive

After breakfast, embark on a full-day game drive through the Maasai Mara, Kenya's premier game reserve. Explore its 1510 sq km of rolling grasslands, acacia trees, and riverine bush, home to diverse wildlife including elephants, rhinos, lions, cheetahs, leopards, and more. From June to October, witness the spectacular wildebeest migration as thousands cross the plains and Mara River, where crocodiles lie in wait. Enjoy a picnic lunch at the hippo pool. All meals and overnight stay at Jambo Mara Safari Hotel. Optional early morning balloon safari available for an additional USD 430 per person.



DAY 3

Maasai Mara Game Reserve – Lake Naivasha “A Walk on the Wild Side”

After breakfast, you leave for Lake Naivasha which is the highest Lake in The Rift Valley arriving in good time for lunch. Lake Nai- vasha is famous in the 1930's as a staging post for Imperial Airways Flying Boat Services from Durban to London and you can see the Lake sparkling in the sun thousands of feet below.

Proceed to the hotel for lunch with a visit to the Hell's Gate National Park past Fishers Tower in the afternoon with optional boat ride. Hell's gate is the only park that officially allows transport by walking and bicycling. The small perimeters of the park give you a chance to see a variety of wildlife. Dinner and overnight at Jacaranda Elementaita Hotel.

DAY 4

Lake Naivasha – Amboseli National Park

Today after breakfast, you will depart for Amboseli National Park which is at the foot of Africa's highest mountain; Kilimanjaro. It is one of Kenya's most popular national parks and the best place in Africa to come close to the free ranging elephants. You will arrive in good time for lunch with afternoon game drive. It lies 150 miles south-east of Nairobi, very close to the Tanzania border. The snowcapped peak of Mount Kilimanjaro rising above the clouds dominates every aspect of Amboseli and the Observation Hill which allows an overall view of the whole park especially the swamps and elephants. Dinner and overnight Maasai Simba Camp.



DAY 5

Amboseli National Park – Nairobi

After breakfast, drive back to Nairobi and enjoy an early dinner at the renowned Carnivore restaurant, famous for its charcoalgrilled BBQ. Ranked among the top 50 restaurants globally, Carnivore offers a unique dining experience with a variety of meats including beef, pork, chicken, and exotic game meats like giraffe, zebra, and crocodile. Enjoy all-you-can-eat servings with special sauces, while drinks are charged separately. Dinner starts at 7pm. Afterward, transfer to Swiss Lenana Mount Hotel for overnight stay.



DAY 6

Airport Transfer

Today after breakfast, you will have an airport transfer to catch your flight back home.
